RULES

The Race will be governed by the rules as defined in the current revision of the 2009-20012 Racing rules of Sailing (RRS), its Prescriptions, the Sailing Instructions and a boat's specific class rules . All boats are required to have a working VHF radio on board

ELIGIBILITY

The race is open to all Mono-hull boats with a valid PHRF certificate, and Multi-hull boats over Twenty (21) feet in length. Entrants shall complete registration forms during registration, prior to racing.

SCHEDULE FOR EACH RACE DAY

Registration: 9:00 - 9:30 AM (NO late registrations will accepted)

Skippers Meeting: 9:45 AM

First Shape: 10:30 AM

CLASSES

Classes will be Multi-Hull, "A" class (PHRF 110 and less), "B" Class (PHRF 111 to 149), "C" Class (PHRF 150 to 199), "D" Class (PHRF 200 and above, and will includes Catalina 22s . One boat will constitute a Class, participate and "RACE the FLEET" for corrected time "Braggin' Rights". Results for each race WILL count toward Club Championships.

FEEES

Entry Fee is \$15.00 per race.

Proceeds will be used for Race Committee lunches and a keg on last day of racing, provided there are sufficient funds from registrations. Any extra funds that may be available will be donated to the Fleet Captains for use at the WNR end of season party.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the club bulletin board and at registration.

RACING AREA

The racing area will be in Choctawhatchee Bay.

COURSES

There will be a course to the Mid Bay Bridge and back provided to participants at registration. "D" Fleet will be provided a shorter course. Courses, start sequence and start flag colors will be announced at skippers meeting

PRIZES

An annual perpetual trophy is now available. Class winner names will be engraved on the trophy. Certificates will be awarded to the first three places in each class.
